The Creswell Town Board of Commissioners met on Monday at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Edwin Blount, Commissioner Syble Spruill, Commissioner Ronald Ambrose, Commissioner Joel Harris and Commissioner Brenda Logan.

Commissioner Logan provided the invocation.

Commissioner Spruill provided the Pledge of Allegiance.

-The Mayor informed the board that he had been contacted about the artesian pump not working and wanted to know if the town was going to fix it. Ryan informed the board that the well is pumping sand and the only fix to it is drill another well which would cost a lot of money. The board felt that being it is a landmark of the town; the town needs to look into the problem. Commissioner Ambrose was concern about the liability since it is pumping sand. The board agree for the clerk to contact the attorney and ask about the liability on the artesian well.


