

## Minutes June 10, 2019

The Creswell Town Board of Commissioners met on Monday at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor E. Ray Blount, Commissioner Brenda Logan, Commissioner Syble Spruill, and Commissioner Joel Harris. Commissioner Ron Ambrose was not present.

The Mayor provided the invocation.

Commissioner Spruill provided the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Spruill moved to approve the minutes and waive the reading of the May meeting(s). Commissioner Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The finance summary was presented to the board by the clerk and accepted.

The Mayor opened the Public Hearing for discussion to talk about the special use permit on placing a cemetery on personal property located at 407 West Main Street for the second time. After no further discussion, the public hearing was declared closed.

### Unfinished Business:

-Commissioner Harris moved to approve the Utility Relocation Agreement with NC Department of Transportation. Commissioner Spruill seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

### New Business:

-Commissioner Spruill moved to approve the resolution supporting Healthcare for Eastern NC and Funding Vidant Health. Commissioner Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

-Commissioner Ambrose moved to accept the 2019 audit contract from Cumbee, Taylor & Shook. Commissioner Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

-Commissioner Spruill moved to issue Mrs. Clara Sawyer a special use permit to place a cemetery on her property located at 407 West Main Street with up to 12 family members and abide by all federal and state regulations.

-Timothy Fain appeared before the board with concerns about his high water bill. Ryan wasn't present at the meeting so the board informed Mr. Fain, the Mayor would get with Ryan and check his water meter.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
