

## Minutes November 8, 2021

The Creswell Town Board of Commissioners met on Monday at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Edwin Blount, Commissioner Syble Spruill, Commissioner Ronald Ambrose, Commissioner Brenda Logan and Commissioner Joel Harris.

Commissioner Ambrose provided the invocation.

Commissioner Spruill provided the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Spruill moved to approve the minutes and waive the reading of the October meeting(s). Commissioner Ambrose seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The finance summary was presented to the board by the clerk and accepted.

### New Business:

-Alfredia Williams appeared before the board informing them of an issue she has had with an inoperable sewer collection tank. Mrs. Williams informed the board that the sewer is currently functioning but for over a year it hasn't. Mrs. Williams feels that a credit should be issued for the time the tank was inoperable. The clerk informed the board that the superintendent gave Mrs. Williams a sewer credit for July 2020-Septemebr 2020 and she had service disconnected in September 2020 and connected service back in June 2021. Commissioner Spruill moved to give Mrs. Alfredia Williams a sewer credit for the months, June 2021 through September 2021, that her sewer was inoperable. Commissioner Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

-Joyce Alexander, Lessell Spruill, Grandy Brickhouse and Annie Brickhouse all appeared before the board complaining of discolored water. The board informed them all the issue was being taken care of. A new meter had been installed and the water lines had been flushed but it was going to take some time to get the rust out of the old pipes.

-Commissioner Spruill moved to allow Amy Clifton, office assistant, to work one day a month to help Ryan Swain, Water/Wastewater Superintendent, with reports. Commissioner Ambrose seconded the motion and it carried unanimously. The board agreed that if more time is needed at the beginning for training that would be fine.

-Veteran's Day Celebration is Thursday at 11 am in front of the town office by the monument.


-The Ruritans will hold the Christmas Parade on December 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 at 3 p.m.
