

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE
TOWN OF CRESWELL IMPLEMENTING FOUR-YEAR
STAGGERED TERMS FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CRESWELL:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. §160A-101 and §160A-102, the charter of the Town of Creswell as set forth in Chapter Sixty (60) of the 1873-74 Private Session laws of the State of North Carolina, as amended, is hereby further amended to provide that the members of the town council shall hereafter be elected for four-year terms on a staggered basis as follows: At the regular municipal election to be held in 1979, the two candidates who receive the highest number of votes shall be elected to four-year terms, while the two candidates who receive the next highest number of votes shall be elected for two-year terms. Beginning at the regular municipal election to be held in 1981, and every two (2) years thereafter, two members of the council shall be elected to serve for four-year terms.

Section 2. Subject to any referendum petitioned for and conducted pursuant to N.C.G.S. §160A-103, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 14, 1978.
