

Minutes September 14, 2020

The Creswell Town Board of Commissioners met on Monday at 7:00 p.m. with the following members present: Commissioner Syble Spruill, Commissioner Ronald Ambrose, Commissioner Joel Harris and Commissioner Brenda Logan. The Mayor was not present.

Commissioner Ambrose provided the invocation.

Commissioner Spruill provided the Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Spruill moved to approve the minutes and waive the reading of the August meeting(s). Commissioner Harris seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

The finance summary was presented to the board by the clerk and accepted.


Unfinished Business:

-Ryan Swain presented to the board some price quotes for a 5' x 8' utility trailer to haul the mosquito sprayer. Price quotes ranged from \$750 - \$1,048 depending on what type of flooring it had: mesh, wood, or steel. Ryan informed the board he wasn't sure which one was better for the price without going and looking at them. Commissioner Spruill moved to give Ryan Swain permission to spend up to \$1,100 on a utility trailer. Commissioner Logan seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

New Business:


- Commissioner Ambrose asked the clerk if she could call the county about the debris on Seventh Street that hasn't been picked up in several weeks.
- The clerk informed the board of someone who needed 24 hours of community service and asked if Maintenance could work the person. The board agreed.
- The clerk informed the board that the front porch rails need repair before they cut someone. The board ask Ryan if he would look into pricing of vinyl rails.
- Fire Department will have a "live burn" in a couple weeks. Commissioner Spruill suggested that the town buy refreshments and water for the firemen. The board agreed.
